

Easy and Cheap Ways to Make Your Home Warmer

Internal and external doors:

- Close the doors of rooms you don't use
- Use a door draught excluder
- Hang a thick curtain over your door
- Fit a letterbox cover or brush, and a keyhole cover
- Fit door frame insulation seal strips to external doors

Windows:

- Close curtains and blinds at dusk, even in rooms you're not using
- Hang thermal curtain liners to your curtains
- Fit thermal film to your windows
- Fit window frame insulation seal strips

Heating system:

- Put radiator reflector foil behind your radiators
- Move furniture away from radiators
- Bleed out radiators that aren't working properly
- Shorten curtains that hang over a radiator, or tuck them up onto the windowsill
- Fit a hot water jacket to your hot water cylinder (at least 80mm or 3 inches thick)
- Fit foam pipe insulation to exposed hot water pipes

Other:

- Fit a chimney balloon draught excluder
- Insulate your loft hatch and your loft or top up the existing insulation (at least 270mm thick)
